THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF KIRKLEES (STREET DRINKING) PUBLIC SPACE PROTECTION ORDER 2023

This Order is made by the Council of the Borough of Kirklees ("the Council) under Section 59 of the Anti-social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 ("the Act").

- 1. This Order relates to the places described in Paragraph 1 of the Schedule below and defined by red and blue colouring on the plans attached to this Order ("the restricted Area"), being public places in the Council's area to which the Act applies.
- 2. The Council is satisfied that the two conditions below have been met, in that:
 - a. Activities carried on in the Restricted Area as described below, have had a detrimental effect on the quality of life of those in the locality, or it is likely that these activities will be carried on in the public place and that they will have such and effect, the said activities being drinking alcohol in a public space.
 - b. That the effect, or likely effect, of the activities described above
 - i. Is, or is likely to be, of a persistent or continuing nature;
 - ii. Is, or is likely to be, such as to make the activities unreasonable; and
 - iii. Justifies the restrictions imposed by this Order.
- 3. The effect of this Order is to impose the following requirements at all times namely:
 - a. That in the Restricted Area any person shall, on being requested to do so by a Police Officer and/or a Police Community Support Officer desist from drinking alcohol in the Restricted Area and
 - b. That in the Restricted Area any person shall, when asked to do so by a Police Officer and/or a Police Community Support Officer surrender anything in that person's possession which the said Officer reasonably believes to be alcohol or a container for alcohol.
- 4. The Order will remain in force for a period of 3 years from the date of this Order, unless extended by further Orders under the Council's statutory powers.
- 5. Any person who fails without reasonable excuse to comply with a requirement imposed upon him by this Order commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 2 on the standard scale or may be issued with a fixed penalty notice requiring payment of a sum not exceeding £100.00.
