

## Kirklees Local Plan Adoption Statement

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Regulations 17, 26 and 35 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended) that the Kirklees Local Plan 2019 was adopted by Kirklees Council on 27<sup>th</sup> February 2019.

The Kirklees Local Plan was submitted to the Planning Inspectorate for Examination on 25<sup>th</sup> April 2017. This examination commenced on 10<sup>th</sup> October 2017 and ran until January 2019.

The Inspectors' Report concluded that, with the recommended main modifications which are set out in their report, that the Kirklees Local Plan satisfies the requirements of Section 20(5) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended) and meets the criteria for soundness in the National Planning Policy Framework.

In accordance with regulations 26 and 35 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended), the Adopted Kirklees Local Plan, Adoption Statement, and Sustainability Appraisal (SA) Report (incorporating Strategic Environmental Assessment SEA) have been published alongside the SA/SEA Post-Adoption Statement in accordance with regulation 16 of The Environmental Assessment of Plans and Programmes Regulations 2004. Any person aggrieved by the Kirklees Local Plan 2019 may, with the leave of the High Court, make an application to the High Court under section 113(3) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended) on the grounds that: (a) the document is not within the appropriate power (as defined in section 113(9) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004); or (b) a procedural requirement has not been complied with.

Any such application must be made to the High Court not later than the 11<sup>th</sup> April 2019 (this represents a period of six weeks for applications beginning with the day after the date on which the Local Plan was adopted).
