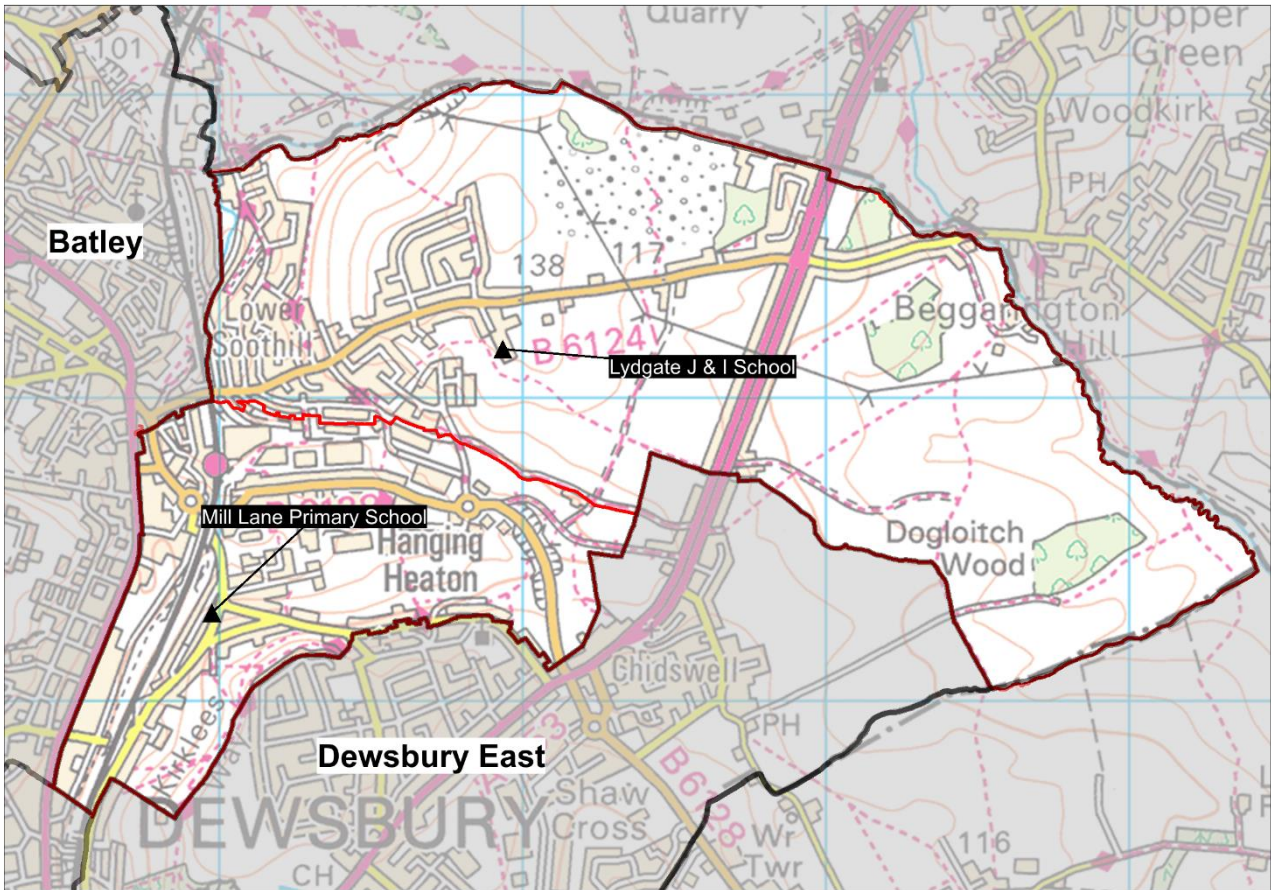


Planning Area 3: Batley East



Overview: The chart on page 72 (and Table B on page 73) shows the demand for Reception places from children resident in this planning area is expected to increase.

In 2022/23 there were unfilled places at both schools in this planning area.

In 2023/24 there were unfilled places at both schools at national offer day. The pattern of pupil distribution illustrates that 55% of the children living in the planning area attend schools in the area, with a number of pupils (24%) attending schools here from neighbouring planning areas, whilst others are securing places in the neighbouring planning area of Batley as well as a small number in schools in other local authorities.

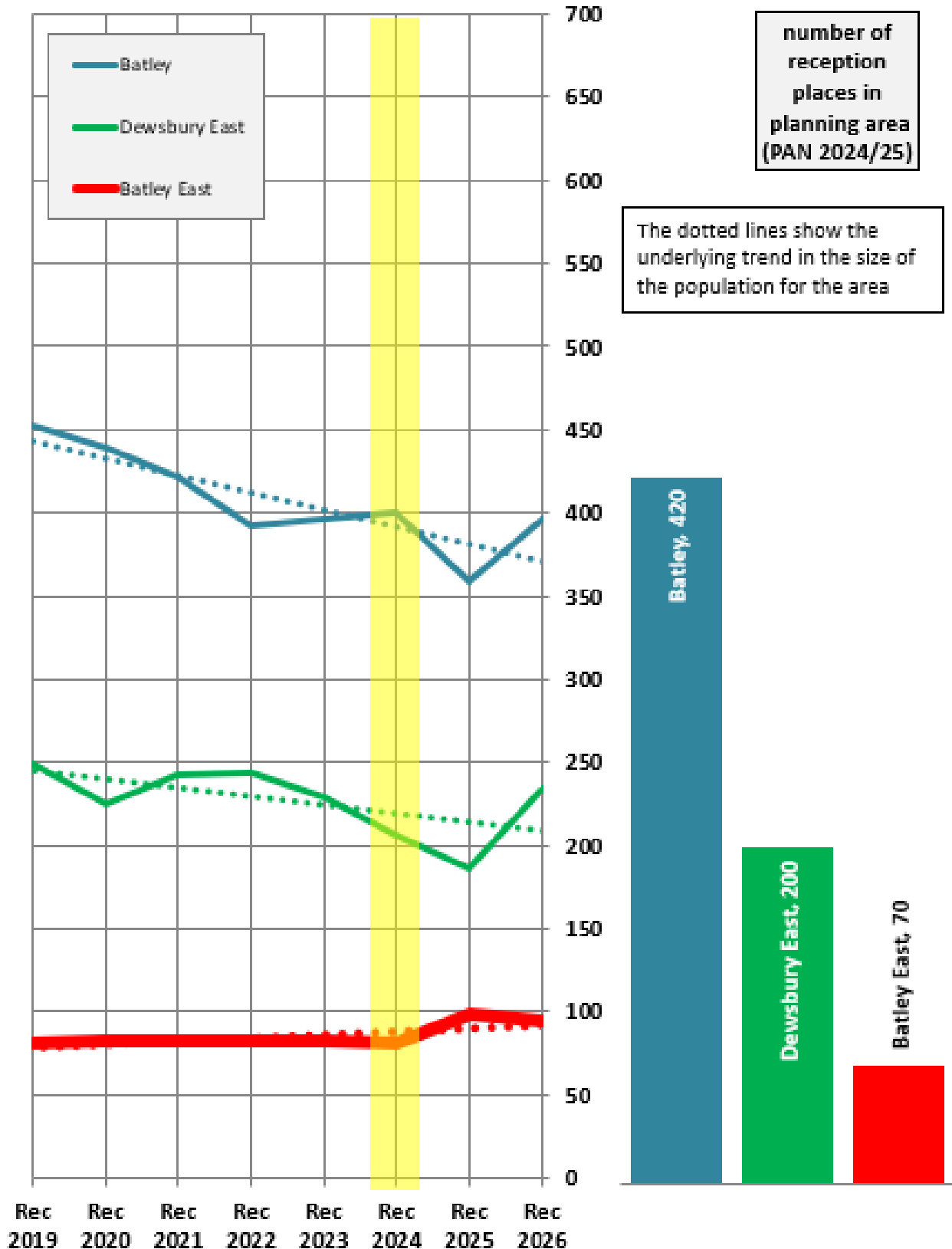
For 2024, 2025 and 2026 population data show demand for places from those living in the planning area will increase slightly compared to previous years. It is recognised there are surplus places in this planning area, but this must be seen in the context of the population increase and the potential impact of housing development. There is a large development providing 319 dwellings where building has commenced, although it isn't expected to be completed for around seven years. There is also a nearby proposed strategic housing development site in the Local Plan. It is important that the impact of these development sites on school places remains under constant review. At this time, no reduction in, or addition to, the number of places is required.
