(On Street Parking Places) (No.4) Order 2020

Various Roads – Huddersfield Town Centre

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees propose to make the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road in the Huddersfield Town Centre in the Kirklees district, will be as follows: -

1. Cross Church Street - to remove the existing pay and display parking place
2. Dundas Street - north side to create two pay and display parking places measuring 38 metres in length to replace the existing one place.
- South side to reduce the existing pay and display parking place to 29 metres in length
3. Half Moon Street - to reduce the existing pay and display parking place to 21 metres in length
4. Queen Street - to remove the existing pay and display parking place
5. Queensgate - to remove the existing pay and display parking place
6. Upperhead Row - to remove the two existing pay and display parking places.

NB. These proposals should be read in conjunction with the other proposals recently advertised concerning these and other roads in Huddersfield town centre.
