Town & Country Planning Act 1990, Section 257. Proposed Diversion of Public Footpath Batley 20 (Part) at Lady Anne Crossing, Batley

Public Path Diversion Application

Notice is hereby given that an application has been received by Kirklees Council to divert part of public footpath Batley 20 at Lady Anne Crossing, Batley. The application is made on the grounds that it is required to implement planning application 2021/93311 for the erection of a new footbridge, ramps and stairs (within a Conservation Area). The planning application includes the erection of walls and fences in place of the existing level crossing gates.

The length of the footpath to be stopped up is shown by the bold solid line. The footpath to be created is shown by the bold dashed line. This new footpath will be available via steps between points C and D or as a ramp, C – G – H – E

The sections of unaffected footpaths are shown by the continuous line with short bars at intervals.
