- (ii) that part of public footpath Meltham 79 having a width of 2.7 metres and shown on the order plan by a bold solid line commencing at point A at grid reference 1009 1076 and proceeding in a westerly then north westerly direction for 115 metres to point C at grid reference 0999 1079

to new lines, which for public footpath Meltham 26 is shown on the order plan by a bold dashed line commencing at point A at grid reference 1009 1076 and proceeding in an east north easterly then west south-westerly direction for 61 Metres via points G and H to point E then north north-westerly then north easterly direction for 57 metres to point D at grid reference 1006 1082; and for public footpath Meltham 79 is shown on the order plan by a bold dashed line commencing at point E at grid reference 1009 1077 and proceeding in a west south-westerly direction for 147 metres to point F at grid reference 0994 1073.
