An alternative footpath will be created, namely a footpath with a width of 2 metres commencing at point C at grid reference SE 2526 2437 and proceeding in a generally northerly direction for approximately 105 metres via point D at grid reference SE 2526 2437 to point B at grid reference SE 2526 2437, with a branch footpath commencing at point D at grid reference SE 2526 2437 and proceeding in a westerly direction for approximately 30 metres to point E at grid reference 2523 2437, as shown on the order map.
