### **NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990, SECTION 257 AND PARAGRAPH 7 OF SCHEDULE 14 KIRKLEES COUNCIL (CLAYTON FIELDS, EDGERTON) PUBLIC PATH STOPPING UP ORDER 2018**

On 11 February 2021, the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs confirmed the above order with modifications.

The effect of the Order as confirmed will be to stop up 6 public footpaths, Huddersfield 477 commencing at its junction with Huddersfield 345 at point A grid reference 1321 1776 and proceeding in an easterly direction for 346 metres to point B at grid reference 1352 1771; Huddersfield 478 commencing at its junction with Edgerton Road at point C at grid reference 1320 1760 and proceeding via point F at grid reference 1325 1762 in a north easterly direction for 257 metres via point G at 1340 1774 to point I grid reference 1341 1774 with a link of a distance of 11 metres from point G grid reference 1340 1774 to point H grid reference 1341 1775, Huddersfield 479 commencing at its junction with Edgerton Road at point E grid reference 1322 1759 and proceeding in a north easterly direction for 42 metres to point F at grid reference 1325 1762, Huddersfield 480 commencing at its junction with Edgerton Road at point C at grid reference 1320 1760 and proceeding in a north easterly direction for 171 metres to point J at grid reference 1330 1774; Huddersfield 481 commencing at its junction with Deveron Grove at point D grid reference 1334 1769 and proceeding in a north westerly direction for 68 metres to point J at grid reference 1330 1774 and Huddersfield 482(part)commencing at point X at grid reference 1339 1779 and proceeding in a south westerly direction for 34 metres to point K at grid reference 1337 1776 as shown on the order map.

Alternative footpaths will be created, namely a footpath commencing at its junction with Queens Road at point N at grid reference 1352 1770 and proceeding in a westerly direction for 292 metres via point W at grid reference 1332 1773 to point T at grid reference 1324 1769; and a footpath commencing at its junction with Queens Road at point P at grid reference 1352 1771 and proceeding in a westerly direction for 150 metres to point O at grid reference 1338 1774; and a footpath commencing at its junction with Edgerton Road at point Q at grid reference 1323 1759 and proceeding in a northerly direction for 177 metres via point S grid reference 1325 1761 and point T grid reference 1324 1769 to point M at grid reference 1321 1772; and a footpath commencing at its junction with path 345 at point R at grid reference 1320 1763 and proceeding in an easterly direction for 57 metres to point S at grid reference 1325 1761; and a footpath commencing at its junction with Deveron Grove at point U at grid reference 1335 1768 and proceeding in a northerly direction for 63 metres via point V grid reference 1334 1772 to point W at grid reference 1332 1773; and a footpath commencing at point V at grid reference 1334 1772 and proceeding in a north easterly direction for 101 metres via points O at grid reference 1338 1774 and point X at grid reference 1339 1779; and

## Woodland walk

A footpath commencing at point Y at grid reference 1321 1777 and proceeding in an easterly direction for 209 metres to point Z at grid reference 1338 1776; and

## Footpath adjacent to Huddersfield 345

A footpath generally 2.5 metres wide (excluding the sub-station) abutting the eastern side of footpath Huddersfield 345 commencing at point # at grid reference 1320 1760 and proceeding in a northerly direction for 158 metres via points R at grid reference 1320 1763 and M at grid reference 1321 1772 to point A at grid reference 1320 1760 as shown on the order map.

**Please note that whilst this order has been confirmed it has not yet come into force.**

The order will come into force on the date on which Kirklees Council certify that the terms of Article 2 of the order have been complied with (and a further notice will be provided at that time), but if any person aggrieved by the order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within 6 weeks from the date on which the notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to the Act.
