Consultation - Definitive Map Modification Order Application (199)

Location: Mean Lane, Meltham
Postcode: HD9 4BU

Kirklees Council has received an application (Reference: 199) under section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, to modify the Definitive Map and Statement and change the recorded status of Mean Lane, Meltham, between the Cricket Ground and Huddersfield Road, from public footpath to public bridleway.

The Council has a duty to maintain a Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way. It must keep the Definitive Map and Statement under continuous review. If we discover evidence that there is an additional public right of way, that is not currently recorded, than an Order to modify the Definitive Map and Statement would be made under the provisions of section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.
