

Floods are one of the most common UK natural disasters.

27,000 properties in Kirklees could be at risk from flooding. That's 15% of homes in the area.

Estimated damage would be over £70 million if they all flooded at once.

You are more likely to get flooded than burgled.

Only 41% of households eligible for free flood warnings are registered to receive them.

40% of businesses do not reopen after suffering a catastrophic loss due to flooding.

A car can float in just 60cm (2 feet) of water.

Just 15cm (6 inches) of fast flowing water can knock you off your feet.

Floods are common and can happen quickly but you can be prepared and minimise your risk.

STEP 1 - Check

STEP 2 - Plan

STEP 3 - Protect

Protect your home or business. If you are at risk from flooding there is a variety of protection equipment you can fit. This includes:

- Sandbags
- Hydrosacks / Hydrosnakes a modern alternative to sandbags
- Toilet seals to stop sewage
- Airbrick covers to prevent water entering the building
- Door / gate barriers to hold back flood water from the house
- Submersible water pumps to help remove water
