


Overview: The chart on page 184 (and Table B on page 185) shows that the demand for Reception places from children resident in this planning area is expected to continue to decline steadily, albeit with fluctuations. Schools are popular in this area with pupils securing places here from the neighbouring planning areas.

In 2022/23 there were unfilled places at three schools.

In 2023/24 there were a very modest number of unfilled places at one school at national offer day. The pattern of pupil distribution illustrates that the majority of children (81%) living in the planning area attend schools in the area. There are significant trends of inward migration into this area, with a large number of pupils (42%) attending schools here from neighbouring planning areas, particularly Cleckheaton, Heckmondwike and Mirfield.

For 2023, 2024 and 2025 population data indicate a steadily declining population trend. There is no need for any additional places.
