The categories of information that we collect, process, hold and share include:

Why we collect and hold this information

We use this personal data in order to:

- Enable us to carry out specific functions for which we are responsible;

The lawful basis on which we use this information

We collect and process information about you under Article 6 (1) (a) and Article 6 (1) (e) of the GDPR regulations.

Storing this information

We will hold the information about you securely, and for no longer than reasonably necessary. We will hold it in line with The Democracy Service Retention Schedule and to comply with statutory requirements.

Who we share this information with

We routinely share this information as necessary with:

- Other services within Kirklees Council (i.e. payroll for Expenses purposes and Document Solutions for paperwork distribution)
- Appellants, providing panel member names at the hearing in accordance with the School Admisson Appeal Code

Why we share this information

We share information with the above on a statutory basis, under section 88(1) (a) and (b) of the [School Standards and Framework Act \(SSFA\) 1998](#). We do not share personal information about you with anyone else without consent unless the law and our policies allow us to do so.
