(On Street Parking Places) (No.1) Order 2022

Dundas Street – Huddersfield Town Centre

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees has made the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects Dundas Street in Huddersfield Town Centre in the Kirklees district, will be as follows:

- a) to reduce the current length of pay and display parking on the north-eastern side to 25 metres, starting from a point 36 metres southeast of Upperhead Row
- b) to remove the length of pay and display parking on the southwest side altogether.

NB. These proposals should be read in conjunction with the recently advertised proposals associated for the restrictions for Dundas Street under (Traffic Regulation) (No 31) Order 2021.

The Order was made on 2nd August 2022 and will take effect on Monday 8th August 2022.

Any person wishing to challenge the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any requirements of that, or of any instrument made under it, have not been complied with may apply to the High Court within six weeks following 4th August 2022.
