This Order is made by Kirklees Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the West Yorkshire Metropolitan County Council Definitive Map and Statement for the Kirklees Area require modification in consequence of events specified in Section 53(3)(c)(i) and (ii), namely, the discovery by the Authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows:

that a right of way that is not shown in the Map and Statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path, and

that a highway shown in the Map and Statement as a highway of a particular description ought to be there shown as a highway of a different description.

The authority have consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates.

The Kirklees Council hereby order that:-

- For the purpose of this Order the relevant date is 22 February 2024.
- 2. The West Yorkshire Metropolitan County Council Definitive Map and Statement for the Kirklees Area shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
- 3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the "Kirklees Council (Meltham 70 and Meltham 38 (part) Wilshaw Road to Wood Nook Lane, Meltham) Definitive Map Modification Order 2024".

PART I

MODIFICATION OF DEFINITIVE MAP

DESCRIPTION OF PATH OR WAY TO BE ADDED

A public bridleway shown on the map attached to the Order by a continuous black line with cross bars at intervals commencing at the current termination point of path Meltham 38, as shown on the Definitive Map, at grid reference SE 1208 1065 (Point C on the map) and proceeding in a generally east south-easterly direction for approximately 50 metres, passing Wood Nook House, to its junction with Wood Nook Lane at grid reference SE 1213 1063 (Point D on the map). The bridleway has a width varying between 3.1 and 3.5 metres as shown edged and hatched blue on the map.

DESCRIPTION OF PATHS OR WAYS TO BE UPGRADED

- (1) The full length and width of existing footpath Meltham 70 to be upgraded to bridleway and shown on the map attached to the Order by a continuous black line with cross bars at intervals commencing on Wilshaw Road at grid reference SE 1203 0961 (Point A on the Order map) and proceeding in a generally northerly direction for approximately 1015 metres to its junction with Meltham 38 near the ruin of Lower Cote at grid reference SE 1189 1057 (marked B on the map). The bridleway has a width varying between 4.6 and 6.7 metres as shown hatched / edged blue on the Order map.
- (2) Part of existing footpath Meltham 38 to be upgraded to bridleway and shown on the map attached to the Order by a continuous black line with cross bars at intervals commencing at its junction with Meltham 70 near Lower Cote at grid reference SE 1189 1057 (marked B on the Order map) and proceeding in a generally east northeasterly then south easterly direction for approximately 232 metres to the current termination point of Meltham 38 as shown on the Definitive Map near Wood Nook House at grid reference SE 1208 1065 (marked C on the Order map). The bridleway has a width varying between 3.5 and 5 metres as shown hatched / edged blue on the Order map.


