I fully support the Lidl store's planning application to build on the long neglected site of the Spotted Cow inn. There is a paucity of shops between Oakes and Pole Moor. This was not always the case in the past - the 3 shops at Mount departed some time ago, as did others in Outlane and Salendine Nook.
