I am opposed to the construction as it will increase congestion in the area, which is already bad in rush hour due to the school run. I am concerned about noise pollution during the day and light pollution from the store during the night. The row of houses directly next to the proposed car park will lose all privacy in their back garden and upstairs windows. What will Lidl do to prevent this? Will they plant trees? The increased traffic caused by this will result in a high likelihood of children being run over going to school.

There are lots of natural animal habitats on the land currently, the construction will result in animal nests and structures being destroyed. Has Lidl checked for any protected species present on the land? Will habitats be maintained or does Lidl plan on building right on top of them?

There is a Sainsbury's less than 100 metres up the road, it is already serving the area well, there is no need for another supermarket. Sainsbury's and other businesses in the Salendine Nook shopping centre could end up going out of business and people losing their jobs. There is no need for two supermarkets within walking distance of each other.
