Hi Adam

We discussed the below consultation response from your rights of way officers on our call before Christmas.

As we explained on that call, it appears there has been a misunderstanding and we can confirm that the proposal will not alter or have any impact on the existing public right of way to the east of the site.

I have attached the proposed Boundary Treatments Plan (which formed part of the application submission) and also a new section drawing for reference which shows the proposed levels and boundary treatments to the east of the site following completion of the development.

As you will note, the existing fence and railings either side of the footpath will remain in situ. A new 1.5m open-boarded timber fence will be installed at the top of the retaining wall within the site. There will then be a landscaped area of several metres diameter between this fence and the existing fence at the edge of the footpath.

I hope that clarifies the situation however feel free to give me a call if you want to discuss.

With regards to this application, the area around the boundary adjacent to the public footpath does not appear to have been amended. The public footpath is not included in the proposals, prow have made comments on this previously

Public footpath Huddersfield has a recorded width of 1.5 m and runs along the eastern boundary. The proposal does not indicate how the path will be dealt with. The block plan indicates that the existing fence/railings will be retained. However, the proposed retaining wall indicates a 8m or 9m retaining wall with open boarded time fencing to rear or the wall is shown on the retaining wall elevations

Please clarify how the design and retaining wall will be incorporated in with the footpath
