(On Street Parking Places) (No. 1) Order 2024

Bond Street, Dewsbury Town Centre

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees propose to make the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to remove 3 of the existing 4 lengths of pay and display parking places in Bond Street, (the parking place on the north side at the eastern end nearest Northgate is unaffected), but to introduce a new parking place on the south side from a point 28 metres west of Union Street for 12 metres which will operate at all times but which between 8am and 6pm on Mondays to Saturdays will be restricted to payment for parking at 80p for up to 45 minutes and £1.60 for up 90 minutes with a maximum stay of 90 minutes and no return within 60 minutes.

NB: These proposals should be read in conjunction with the recently advertised proposals associated with the changes to other restrictions in Bond Street under the (Traffic Regulation) (Consolidation Order Providing On-Street Parking Places, Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions and Migration to a 'Map-Based' Format) Order 2024 (Amendment No. 6) Order 2024.

These are amended proposals from those originally advertised at the end of last year.
