NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Kirklees Council propose to introduce the following traffic calming features on Lea Lane, Honley/Netherton.

Feature 1 – Two speed cushions from a point 120 metres south-west and south-east of the projected southern kerbline of Wrigley Court for a distance of 3.5 metres in a south-easterly direction.

Feature 2 – Two speed cushions from a point 73 metres south-west of the projected southern kerbline of Wrigley Court for a distance of 3.5 metres in a south-westerly direction.

Feature 3 – Two speed cushions from a point 10 metres south-east of the projected southern kerbline of Wrigley Court for a distance of 3.5 metres in a south-westerly direction.

Feature 4 – Two speed cushions from a point 3 metres south of the projected southern kerbline of Cocking Steps Lane for a distance of 3.5 metres in a southerly direction.

Speed cushions will be 75 millimetres high, 3.5 metres long and 1.6 metres wide with the gaps between each cushion in a double set to be no larger than 1.2 metres in width to suit existing road widths.
