VARIOUS ROADS IN HUDDERSFIELD

Statement of reasons for proposing to make the order

This order is proposed to introduce restrictions on a number of roads within Huddersfield.

The order is proposed to allow the introduction of No Waiting at Any Time restrictions on St Helen's Gate; for a combination of No Waiting at Any Time and No Waiting at Certain Times restrictions on Newsome Road South and Plantation Drive; No Waiting at Any Time and repositioned loading bay on Quay Street; and a No Waiting at Any Time/No Loading at Any Time restriction on Queen Street

- 1. St Helen's Gate, Almondbury
 - To prevent parking and ease access and egress along the carriageway.
- 2. Newsome Road South & Plantation Drive, Newsome
 - To prevent parking around junctions and traffic island.
- 3. Quay Street, Huddersfield
 - To improve access for goods vehicles and improve visibility out of a number of accesses.
- 4. Queen Street, Huddersfield
 - To prevent parking in a recently installed turning head.

It is believed these proposals will improve highway safety for all road users.
