Feature 1 of 3 – Kerb-to-kerb plateaux 75mm high and 15m long including 1.5m long / 1:20 ramps, located on Woodhouse Hill, with its south-western limit 2.6m southwest of the projected southwestern kerbline of Central Avenue.

Feature 2 of 3 – Kerb-to-kerb plateaux 75mm high and 9m long including 1.5m long / 1:20 ramps, located on Woodhouse Hill, with its centre point 33.44m southwest of the projected centreline of Woodhouse Hall Road, measured along the centreline of Woodhouse Hill.

Feature 3 of 3 – Kerb-to-kerb plateaux 75mm high and 4.95m long including 1.125m long / 1:15 ramps, located on Woodhouse Hall Road, with its centre point 40.78m east of the junction with Woodhouse Hill, measured along the centreline of Woodhouse Hall Road.
